

Souhegan High School Driver Education Program

Location: Room 127, class size of 10-30 students

Vehicles: Mazda 6, red YIKES+, automatic transmission

Scion, tan NERVUS, standard transmission

Mazda 6, silver OOOPS-, automatic transmission

Cost: \$575, due in full the first day of class. There are no refunds for incomplete courses.

Requirements: Classroom portion: 30 hours of classroom activity, (lecture, videos, 3 quizzes, review, and a test.) Students must receive 80% on the final test to receive credit for the course. Please come to class with a copy of your birth certificate, pen, notebook, and the state manual which will be provided the first day of class.

Behind the wheel training: 10 hours of driving the driver education car. Driving time is offered after school and on weekends. Students are picked up and dropped off from home, school, or work at their convenience in the local area. Each student drives in the city, on a multi-lane highway, learns forward, reverse, and parallel parking, lane changes, and practices drive-up windows in addition to country driving.

Observation: 6 hours of watching another student drive in the driver education car. This is usually done after the student's driving session.
