Tuition:                    **\$275 per course payable by the first day of class**

Eligibility:                A student receiving a final grade of “no credit” (NC) in a class is eligible to repeat that course in summer school, with teacher approval and providing the student received a passing grade (C- or better) for at least one trimester.

Attendance:              Any student taking a course for credit is allowed a maximum of two absences (excused or unexcused) in each course. A violation of this policy will result in the student receiving no credit (NC) for that course. There will be no refund for an attendance violation.

Grades:                    All parents/guardians will receive a report documenting the student’s progress during the third week of summer school.

The summer school final grade does not replace the student’s year-end grade on the final transcript. Both grades will appear on the transcript with summer school enrollment noted and only the most recent grade computed in the student’s grade point average.
